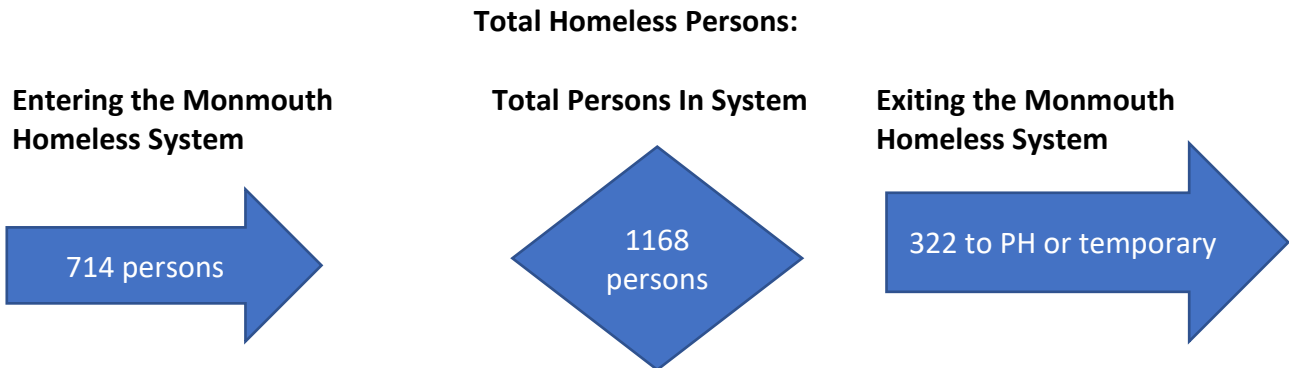




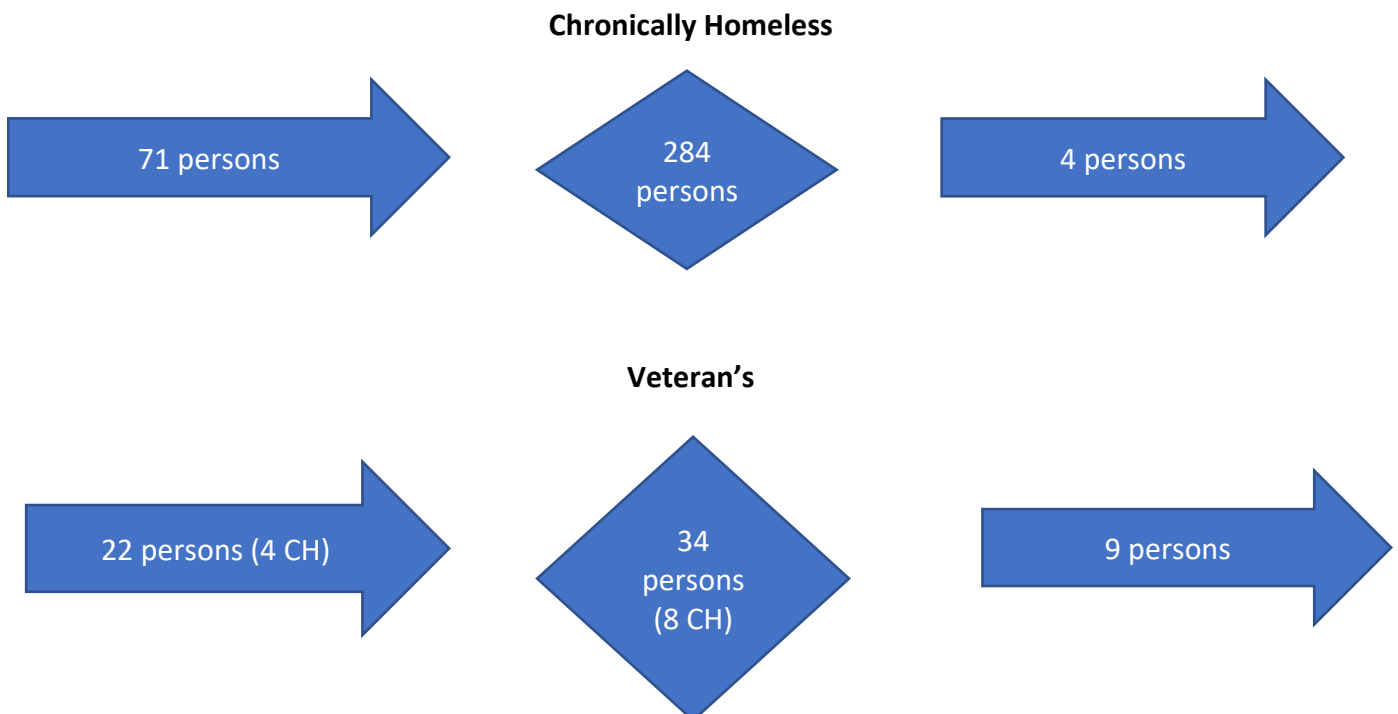
Monmouth County Homeless Systems Collaborative Executive Summary

2020 Goal:

- To end chronic homelessness in Monmouth County by 2025
- To end Veteran's homelessness in Monmouth County by 2022
- Data for 10/01/2019-12/31/2019:



*due to the way Emergency Shelter programs are set up in HMIS the number of homeless persons entering the system may be inflated



Executive Committee Goals:

- Explore opportunities to expand affordable housing stock in Monmouth County
- Meet with builders and developers of affordable housing to explore options
- Develop relationships with community stakeholders (politicians, funders, advocacy organizations) to help support the goals of the HSC
- Engage with housing authority's individually to address any concerns or resistance in establishing a homeless preference
- HSC will host a presentation with all housing authority's invited (invitation will come from the PH subcommittee) encouraging participation with the HSC and asking for a homeless preference

Subcommittee Goals:

Permanent Housing

- Compose a letter inviting the public housing authority's inviting them to collaborate with the HSC
- Explore 'Housing Rehab' funding options

Veteran's

- Case conferencing will merge with new Housing Navigator Committee and Veteran's subpopulation will be discussed at this meeting
- Continue to monitor the benchmarks for ending Veteran's Homelessness
- Identify barriers to housing Veteran's and explore possible solutions

Housing Navigator/Case management conferencing (new committee)

- Housing Navigator will begin case conferencing meetings monthly to "work the list"
- First meeting is Wednesday March 11th at 2pm in the Ag building

Coordinated Systems

- Identify current members of the committee and identify which agencies/advocates/partners should also be attending
- Explore opportunities to expand partnerships with Child Care Resources and Workforce Development
- Streamline referral process between the HSC and these resources
- Formalize partnership with MOUs
- Monitor the Coordinated Assessment process and ensure the sheltering agencies are completing assessments
- Identify barriers and explore possible solutions to ensure that all sheltering agencies are utilizing HMIS

- Review Letter of Support Policy

Discharge Planning

- TBD; will be analyzing data in HMIS about the connection between hospital discharges and the Monmouth Homeless system
- Identify an administrator at one Monmouth County hospital to have a strategic planning meeting and discuss possible solutions to recidivism rates

Point in Time

- Working with Monarch on the de-duplication process
- Will disseminate and discuss implications of the formal PIT report when it is released

Review Committee

- Meets during the local selection/CoC NOFA process
- Responsible for development of monitoring/application/scoring materials
- Complete the review of applications and ranking of projects for the CoC application
- Reviews all CoC funded projects to insure projects are operating within HUD guidelines
